NY Pythians Initiate NEW Lodge, Knights & Install Officers

New York proudly initiated a brand new lodge, the third lodge in New York to admit women as members and the first to initiate women as Knights, Tuesday, December 7, 2021 in the Windsor Terrace section of Brooklyn. Elizabeth Gloucester Lodge #867 initiated nine new members of the order including five women. The following received their obligations as new Knights of the Order Knights of Pythias: (See page one photo by PDGC Craig Kligfeld, Left to right) Katie Libutti, Timothy Pattison, Abby Login, Colin McDonald, Caley Clocksin, Charles Woodbury, Amy Whitehouse and Jason Bolen. Not pictured: Valerie Kelleher. The new Lodge adopted its name from abolitionist and philanthropist Elizabeth A. Gloucester who amassed a fortune from running more than 15 boardinghouses, including the Remsen House in Brooklyn, which drew clientele from members of New York's elite. Considered by many to be the richest black woman in America at her death at age 66 on August 9, 1883, she also raised money for New York's Colored Orphan Asylum. Find her grave at Green-Wood Cemetery in Brooklyn. Colin McDonald was elected and installed as Chancellor Commander.
