





# College Scholarships Applications Available!

Dear Pythian Member (parent or grandparent),

Don't miss out on \$4000 worth of available college scholarships from Grand Lodge.

In order for your grandchild/child to receive this scholarship, your child or child-in-law (the parent of the recipient) must be (1) a Pythian for two years prior to applying for this scholarship; (2) a member of any Lodge in New York State; and (3) remain a member throughout their child's college career.


