RAMAPO CEMETERIES

Several Brothers have asked me about cemetery benefits. Seems that there is some confusion. The following is excerpted from Triangle By-laws.

1. Only Brothers in Ramapo Lodge #485 and their immediate families are eligible.

2. Our contract with Sons of Israel for the purchase of our cemetery included a requirement that only those of the Jewish Faith could be buried in this cemetery. We purchased twelve non-denominational plots across Brick Church Road for members and/or spouses who are not of the Jewish Faith. Two are currently used or assigned at this time.

3. The Brother must also be a member of Triangle Club. It is never too late for a current Ramapo Brother to join Triangle Club. Initiation fees are based on age at time of joining. There are no dues. Brothers who are members of Triangle Club have a choice of \$200.00 death benefit or two cemetery plots, not necessarily contiguous. Brothers who have chosen cemetery plots in the past, could make them contiguous for a \$200.00 additional charge. Almost everyone who chose plots also chose contiguous plots. If you know you have two plots, there is a 99% chance you also paid for contiguous plots.

4. Brothers from Levona Acme Lodge who transferred to Ramapo Lodge in 2005, are included in all of the above. Levona Acme Lodge distributed a portion of their benefits fund to their brothers and delivered the balance to Ramapo Lodge to cover costs related to the transfer process.

5. We recently learned that Levona Acme Benevolent Association owned three cemeteries for their members and that these were given over to Ramapo Lodge to administer in accordance with Ramapo Endowment Fund Rules. The cemeteries are Beth Moses on Long Island, Cedar Park in New Jersey and King David in Putnam County.

6. Many of the transferred Levona Acme members already own plots in these cemeteries and are entitled to burial in one of these cemeteries at no additional cost for the graves. Some are not enrolled and will be allowed to purchase plots at the same rates as Ramapo Brothers pay. The charge to members who have not previously enrolled is as follows.

- a. Initiation into Triangle Club if not already a member. This fee depends on age at time of joining.
- b. \$400.00 per grave. If two graves are purchased, add \$200.00 per pair contiguous fee.

7. The by-laws relating to children are as follows.

- a. Sons up to the age of 18 unless enrolled in full time college, in which case the age is 21. Other sons over age 18 must become Pythians.
- b. Unmarried daughters of any age, including divorcees.

8. With the addition of the three new cemeteries, Ramapo Lodge now owns more graves than needed. As a result, we have made our requirements much more liberal. The Committee will review circumstances on an individual basis, and bend over backwards to help our members in need. Any Brother may select any cemetery in any location.

- a. We have granted plots to "challenged" children of members who do not meet the age requirement.
- b. We will accept families where the husband is a member of another Lodge.

9. Finally, Harvey Rosenshein and I have pledged to continue to administer all the cemeteries for as long as we are able, even if Ramapo Lodge should close. It is important to recognize that Triangle Club is financially and legally separated from Ramapo Lodge and the Endowment Fund is a subsidiary of Triangle Club.


